Literacy

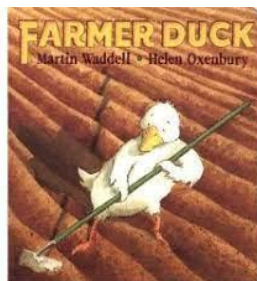
- Write a sentence about something you have been brave with.
