Development

- Talk about your feelings for finishing Reception and moving into Year 1.
- Talk about our value of Respect. Why is it important to be respectful? Can you think of a time when you have found it hard to be respectful?

Literacy

- Write a postcard from somewhere you would like to go on holiday. Say what it is like there and how you will get there.
- Write a vehicle fact file. Think about what your chosen vehicle looks like, does, where it is used etc.

Understanding the World

- Find out about a different tradition or custom from around the world.
- Go on a transport hunt to see how many different vehicles you can find.

Transport



Core skills to practise each week:

- Share your reading book with a grown up at least 5x a week
- Keep practising your sounds
- Practise reading **and** writing your tricky words.

Physical Development

- Practise hopping. How many times can you hop on each foot?
- Practise kicking a ball. How many times can you kick it against the wall?
- Can you jump keeping your feet together?

Communication and Language

- Talk about a journey that you have been on. What transport did you use? Where did you go? How did the vehicle move?
- Talk about your favourite things that have happened in our Reception class this year, and say why you enjoyed them.

Mathematics

- Practise saying one more or one less than number to 20 e.g. one less/one more than 16
- Practise number bonds to 10
- Explore measuring things at home. You could think about capacity/weight/height.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Draw a portrait of someone at home. Think carefully about the colours you use.
- Make a collage of a vehicle. Can you find materials of the correct colour to use?
