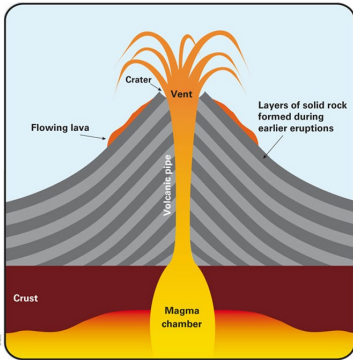
Volcanoes Homework

Reading comprehension:
World volcanoes.

Create a 3D model of a volcano.
Use clay, plaster, papier Mache
or any other materials.

Create a lava painting, collage or
drawing using as many shades of
red or orange as you can

Growth Mindset challenge:
Brilliant Brain.

Write a shape poem of a volcanic
eruption using onomatopoeic (sound)
words. E.g. BANG! CRASH!
WHOOSH!

Find and compare the heights of
different volcanoes. Present your
findings in a table.

SPELLING INVESTIGATION:

We are going to be learning about the /ei/
sound eg wait, eight, vein, straight, they.
Create an activity to help other children
learn about all the ways we can spell this
sound.

Make a set of Top Trumps cards
for different volcanoes.

Create a poster about a volcano
of your choice e.g. Etna, Vesuvius.
Draw the volcano and add soe
facts to your poster.
