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Purpose

The St Francis Primary School uniform is designed to:

- Promote collective smartness and a sense of pride in belonging to our school.
- Ensure practicality and suitability for the children's working day.
- Encourage equality and a positive school ethos.

We request parents' full support in adhering to this policy.

Please note: Trainers or sports shoes should only be worn with PE uniform.

All items of clothing **must be clearly labelled** with your child's name.

School Uniform

- **Top:** Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan, preferably with the school logo
- **Shirts/Blouses:** White shirt or blouse, or white/navy blue short-sleeved "aertex" shirt, preferably with the school logo
- **Bottoms:** Charcoal grey school trousers or shorts, skirt, or pinafore dress
- **Dresses:** Navy and white checked dress
- **Socks/Tights:** White or grey socks, blue or grey tights
- **Shoes:** Sensible, low-heeled black shoes
- **Summer:** Hat for sun protection
- **Outdoor Learning:** Wellies for outdoor play, which can be left in school

School Logo: We encourage all children to have at least one item of clothing with the school logo, especially for school trips.

Physical Education (PE)

Each child is placed in a house and wears a **house-coloured round-neck T-shirt**.

Houses:

- Longleat – Yellow
- Bowood – Red
- Lydiard – Green
- Avebury – Purple

PE Kit:

- House T-shirt
- Plain black shorts

- Dark trainers
- Royal blue sweatshirt and joggers (alternatively black or navy joggers)

Bags and Lunch

- School book bag or small backpack
- Lunch boxes should be small
- Every child must have a **named water bottle**. Children are encouraged to drink water throughout the day. (Non-fizzy drinks are permitted only with lunch.)

Hair

- Long hair must be tied up
- Hair accessories should be small and preferably in school colours

Jewellery

- Safety is the primary consideration
- Children may wear watches, but they must be removed for PE and some activities. Watches with internet access are **not permitted**
- Only small stud earrings may be worn and must be removed or covered for PE sessions
- No other jewellery is allowed unless agreed with the Headteacher for **medical or religious reasons**
